PEFINDO has assigned its "idA" financial strength rating to PT Asuransi Bangun Askrida (Askrida). The outlook for the rating is "stable".

The rating reflects Askrida's strong synergy with its shareholders, sound liquidity, and above average asset quality. However, the rating is constrained by the Company's modest operating performance, moderate capitalization, and intense competition in the non-captive general insurance market.

The rating may be raised if Askrida could demonstrate substantial and consistent improvement in its business profile, which must be accompanied by convincing evidence of better underwriting practices, resulting in a significant improvement of its operating performance and capitalization profile. Conversely, the rating may be lowered if the Company's capitalization or liquidity indicators deteriorate, or if Askrida's business position declines markedly.

Established in 1989, Askrida is a general insurance company focusing on its captive market in credit insurance for regional development banks (BPDs). Its shareholders comprised 51 entities, including regional governments, BPDs, pension funds, and employee foundations. Its largest shareholders as of September 30, 2022, was Pemerintah Provinsi Sumatera Barat (15.62%).

Rating Definition

An insurer rated idA has strong financial security characteristics relative to those of other companies in Indonesia, but is somewhat more likely to be affected by adverse business conditions than insurers with higher ratings.
